## Mentor Safety Town

For more than a quarter of a century, Mentor Safety Town has been helping preschoolers and their parents by providing them with peace of mind. In conjunction with the Mentor Police Department, we coordinate all aspects of “Safety Town”, the safety awareness program for community children.

We collect corporate sponsorships, promote public awareness, register participants, recruit teen volunteers, and hire teachers.

## Fundraiser
